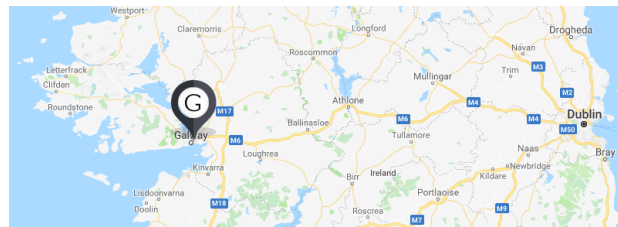

Biographies

Dr Rolf Behrents has lectured extensively in the United States and abroad. The 2018 Educational Leadership Conference honoured Dr Rolf G. Behrents as one of the profession's most prolific and influential orthodontists over the last several decades. He is the editor-in-chief of the AJO-DO and chair of the Department of Orthodontics at the Saint Louis University Centre for Continuing Dental Education. An active researcher and editorial contributor to numerous books, Dr Behrents is the author of *Growth of the Aging Craniofacial Skeleton*. Material from this monograph is included in the textbook *Contemporary Orthodontics* by Dr William Proffit, published in several languages. Dr Behrents has published more than 70 articles and has been a research associate of the Bolton-Brush Growth Study Centre of Case Western Reserve University since 1984.

Christian Url received his degree as a software engineer from Vienna University of Technology and began working in medical technology in 1999, specialising in robot technology and 3D virtualization in orthodontics. He has over 15 years of experience in using and teaching the OnyxCeph³ software suite, he has written numerous international articles and delivered presentations on the software. He has been a lecturer at the School of Dental Science, Trinity College Dublin since 2014.
